ON THE RELEASE OF REPORTS ON (1) BUDGET TRACKING AND ANALYSIS OF THE NATIONAL BUDGET AND (2) IN THE MATTER OF MALMED HEALTHCARE SERVICES LIMITED AND BLANTYRE DHO ALLEGED PREFERENTIAL TREATMENT TO ASIANS/INDIANS ON COVID-19 VACCINATION

The Malawi Human Rights Commission ("The Commission") conducted a nationwide human rights-based budget tracking and analysis of 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 National Budgets respectively, and an investigation into the alleged preferential treatment to Asians/Indians on Covid-19 vaccination by MALMED Healthcare Services Limited (Blantyre Clinic) and Blantyre District Health Office (DHO). The 2 reports for budget tracking and the alleged preferential treatment of Asians/Indians on Covid-19 vaccinations are now ready for dissemination.

The Commission will therefore release these 2 reports to relevant stakeholders (including the parties involved) on **Friday**, **23**rd **April 2021 at Crossroads Hotel in Lilongwe** starting from **9:30 am to 11:30 am**. In conformity with strict Covid-19 measures, the room will only accommodate a maximum of 50 invited people which also includes 6 invited media houses.
